Apprenticeship is a working relationship between an employer and an employee during which time the apprentice, learns a trade. Apprenticeship trains in every aspect of the trade and includes on the job and technical related instruction. Ironworkers learn skills in major categories and many other job tasks. On-The-Job training is hands-on applied learning, while the technical related instruction teaches the tricks of the trade and the theory behind those techniques. Related instruction classes are generally held in the evening or on weekends so the apprentice can work at the trade and earn a living. It is very important to remember that an apprentice is an employee who earns wages and benefits during the normal work week.

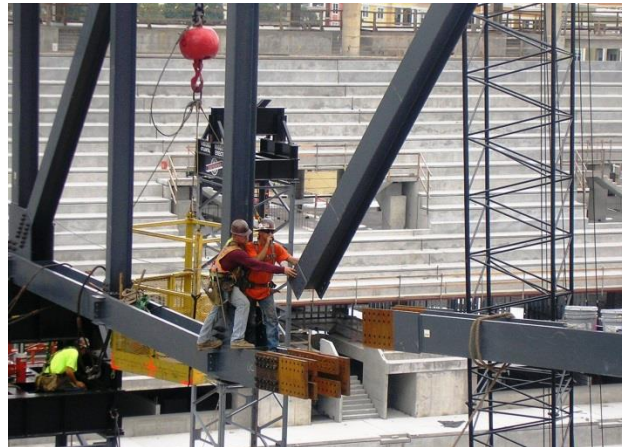

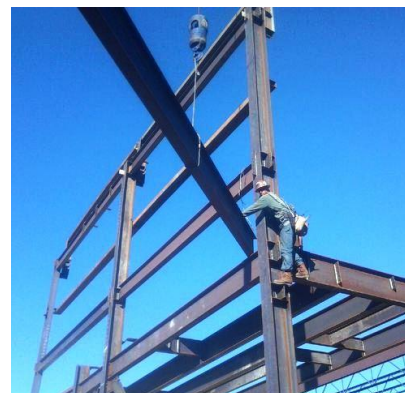
